### **Positives**

#### Parents

- Parents were very complimentary of the school environment, the standard of teachers in the school and the greater involvement they would be having next academic year
- Many thought issues on behaviour were dealt with quickly and fairly
- Almost everyone surveyed would recommend the school

#### Students

- Students stated they enjoyed the curriculum they were working towards and the freedom it gave them

#### Staff

- Staff were the most positive about the school environment and facilities

### **Areas to improve**

#### Parents

- Supervision was felt to still be an area the school could improve on - DONE
- Parents suggested they would like to see a greater range of ECAs throughout the school year
- An outdoor play area was deemed to be lacking from the grounds
- Wanted greater consultation with staff about their child's progress

#### Students

- Some students felt that certain staff spoke to them in a condescending or in an aggressive way  
There was some mention of some teachers' dress being inappropriate for the working environment or the culture they are in
- Many saw detention as not being a deterrent because it just stopped them from 'dancing', which they did not want to do anyway - DONE
- Students mentioned the smell of the building and that little had been done about it
- Many wanted more sports facilities
- Secondary students wanted their own area - DONE

#### Staff

- Staff felt that the current curriculum needs greater improvement - DONE
- Staff felt that the ECAs should be more closely linked to the skills students will need when they begin leave school and begin work
- Staff wanted Q present during briefings and meetings and greater communication
