In response to the rapidly evolving situation regarding COVID-19, Bloomsbury International School Hatyai is making the following important update to its previously published decision.

THE SCHOOL WILL BE CLOSED ON MONDAY, 24TH FEBRUARY 2020 FOR 1 DAY

We will continue to monitor the COVID-19 situation closely including government announcements. Bloomsbury International School Hatyai will continue to communicate with parents via SMS, email, LINE and Parent Portal as necessary. During this period of COVID-19 outbreak, Bloomsbury International School Hatyai requires a very high level of responsibility and support from all members of our community.

Our Half Term break has just ended and although it was a relaxing time, we now have information that some students, parents and even teachers have travelled overseas to possibly infected areas. This has caused some concern among our community as the 'Corona virus' is still a threat. Therefore, our school must close for one day to determine the severity of this problem.

Please note: Bloomsbury International School Hatyai requires an additional day as we are waiting for the MOE and medical advisors and to gather current data to ensure that it is making the best possible decision for the community regarding those families who have recently travelled to countries where there have been significantly increased recorded cases of the virus.
